

The Board recognizes and appreciates that organizations and/or individuals may wish to award grants/gifts to the Kuna School District and/or employees of the District. The District reserves the right to determine if the grant or gift is appropriate and may reject those it deems inappropriate or unsuitable.

To be acceptable, a grant or gift must:

- Have a purpose consistent with the beliefs/philosophy of the District.
- Be offered by a donor acceptable to the Board.
- Not bring undesirable or hidden costs to the District.
- Place no undesirable restrictions on the Board.
- Not be inappropriate or harmful to the best education of students.
- Not imply endorsement of any business or product or belief.
- Not be in conflict with any Board policy or state law.

Any grant or gift should be received in the best interest of the school system. All grants or gifts will become property of the District and will be subject to all State and District policies and procedure, including established District pay schedules.

By acceptance of the grant or gift, the Board makes no commitment to assume financial responsibility for continuation, if the grantor gift becomes exhausted.

Acknowledgement letters must follow IRS guidelines.
