

The Idaho State Board of Education has mandated that all high school students earn five credits in social studies, including government (2 credits), U.S. history (2 credits), and economics (1 credit). Current world affairs and geography are to be integrated into all social studies instruction. Courses such as geography, sociology, world affairs, and world history may be offered as electives, not to be counted as a social studies requirement.

Each year, the high schools in this district will offer at least one (1) social studies elective course, such as geography, sociology, world affairs, or world history. The credits received for such electives will not apply to the social study requirement for graduation.
